For these reasons, ring-bus or breaker-and-a-half switchyard schemes are preferred for transmission switchyards. Three terminal lines are generally not considered acceptable.

This economical layout requires lightweight busbar strain portals only at the ends of the installation, and the bays are narrow. It can be of single or double-row form.

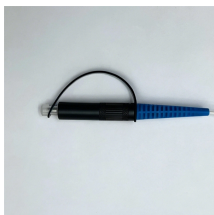
