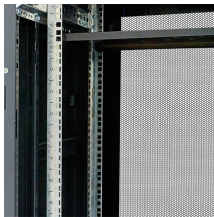
Overview

Port aggregation can increase maximum throughput, and allow for network redundancy. It does this by splitting traffic across multiple ports instead of forcing clients to use a single uplink port on a switch. Link aggregation is sometimes called by other names: The most common device combinations involve connecting a switch to another switch, a server, a network attached storage (NAS). An aggregation switch is a network device that consolidates traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, or other edge devices and forwards it to core switches or routers. 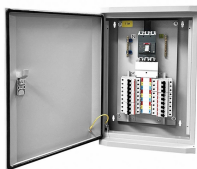
