

Burkina Faso is divided into black and white colors



Overview

The geographic location of what is today Burkina Faso occupies the Upper part of the Volta River which contains three parts: the Black Volta, Red Volta, and White Volta; hence the reason for the 3 stripes. It is virtually identical with the flag of the German Empire, but. Burkina Faso is a landlocked country in West Africa. It covers an area of 274,223 km² (105,878 sq mi). The top stripe is red, while the bottom stripe is green.

The flag of Burkina Faso features the traditional Pan-African colors. These colors were selected to represent the independence of the nation and its unity with other ex-colonies in Africa.



Upper Volta's flag, adopted on December 9, 1959, had black, white, and red stripes referring to the Black Volta, White Volta, and Red Volta rivers. The new Burkinabé flag utilized the pan-African colours of ...



Previously, the country utilized a horizontal tricolor of black, white, and red, which represented the three main branches of the Volta River. Since its 1984 introduction, the current flag has remained the ...



The flag was adopted on August 4, 1984, when President Thomas Sankara renamed the country from Upper Volta to Burkina Faso, meaning "Land of Upright People." The previous Upper Volta flag — ...

It showed three horizontal stripes in black, white and red. The three colors stood for the three arms of the river Volta (Red Volta, White Volta and Black Volta).



Education in Burkina Faso is divided into primary, secondary and higher education. The Education Act makes schooling compulsory from age 6 to 16, with French as the official language of instruction.



They are (1.) the Black Volta, (2.) the White Volta and (3.) the Red Volta. The other main river is the Niger and one of the few permanent lakes in West Africa, Lake Bama, is situated on the White Volta.



The old flag that was adopted in 1959 which had white, black, and red colors to represent the three Volta river branches was replaced by the new red and green flag with the yellow star. The ...



The color palette of the Burkina Faso flag is intentionally minimalistic yet powerful, comprising three colors, each chosen for its significance and the ability to stand out.
