

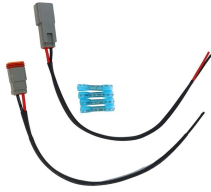

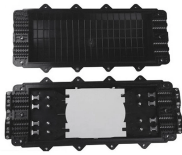
Overview

A cold aisle is a cooling strategy where the fronts of server racks face each other, creating a dedicated pathway for cool air from the cooling systems to flow directly into the equipment. This configuration minimizes the mixing of hot and cold air, ensuring consistent airflow and. A number of options are available to facilities professionals looking to improve cooling efficiency and reduce resources consumed by their data centers. Beyond implementing basic measures such as sealing moisture out of the data center and improving air flow, aisle containment to prevent the mixing. Cold aisle containment (CAC) is a proven data center cooling strategy that creates physical barriers around cold air supply zones, preventing contamination from hot exhaust air and eliminating the energy-wasting effects of air mixing.

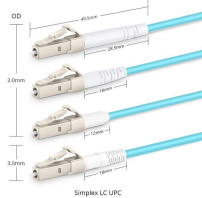
