Type-2 SPDs are more sensitive than type-1, typically rated at 1000+ amps. This will stop most of the surge, and trip in a nanosecond.



Employs a two-tiered protection approach with residual current devices in both the final switch boxes and the preceding sub-distribution or main distribution boxes. Follows the principle of ...



Three level distribution refers to the general distribution box, distribution box, switch box. Two-level protection refers to the leakage protection of the main distribution box and switch box.
