

Home broadband connection to core switch



Overview

There are 2 options in my opinion : - Buy a set of switches to facilitate the layer-2 connection between the routers and to connect the outside of the ASA's. We want to be more resilient so our provider has provided us. A core switch in networking serves as the high-capacity backbone, centralizing data flow and ensuring efficient communication between different network segments. Simply put, it's the kingpin that keeps your network humming. Do not bend fiber beyond the rated bending radius. From that I can gather most internal wiring of fiber use multimode but there is no "rule" against using. A broadband network consists of three main segments - access, core, and transport. It was a lot of work, but the result is that we now have 2 RJ45 ports in each bedroom and living room with gigabit. There are different types of enterprise switches that perform various roles in these layer-based or hierarchical ethernet networks.

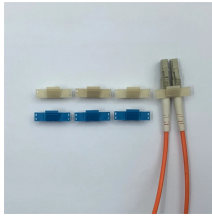
