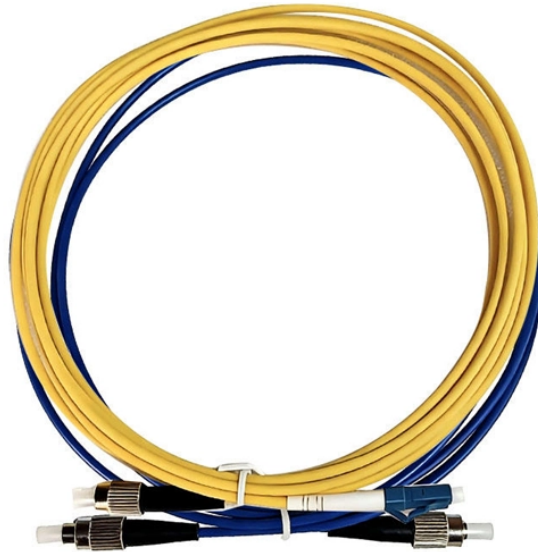


How long should network cables be left in the network cabinet
