

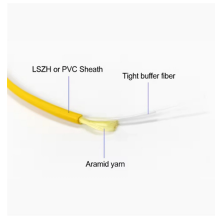
# Minimum spacing between cable trays



## Overview

When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. This spacing is crucial for adequate maintenance access, ease of inspection, and ensuring proper airflow for effective heat dissipation. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Proper installation can significantly reduce electromagnetic interference, prevent fire hazards, and improve overall efficiency. All cables are #10 TC cable with an OD of app 0. The trays are 6" apart with the bottom tray being 5'-0". The NEC requires that cable trays must be supported by members at an interval specified by the cable tray manufacturer, but not more than 5 feet for horizontal runs to support the weight of the cables and other loads.

Cable tray length is selected based on the load to be supported, the distance between the supports (also referred to as the span), and handling and installation constraints.

In general, vertical spacing for cable trays should be 30 cm (12 in), measured from the bottom of the upper tray to the top of the lower tray. A minimum clearance of 23 cm (9 in) should be ...



Support spacing for cable trays must align with the manufacturer's instructions, as outlined in NEC 392.30 (A). Generally, standard trays require supports every 6 to 10 feet, while ...
