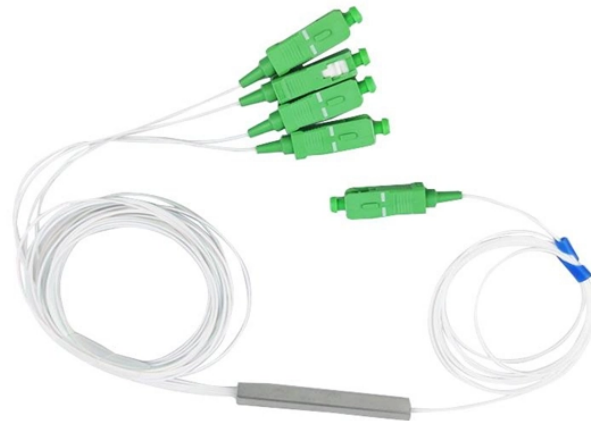

If you have ever glanced at your modem or router and seen an unfamiliar blinking. The Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is a crucial device in modern telecommunications, serving as the interface between your home network and the fiber-optic internet connection provided by your Internet Service Provider (ISP). These blinking or steady indicators aren't random—they tell a clear story about what's working and what isn't. Understanding these color patterns can solve most connectivity issues in minutes, saving you hours of frustration and expensive support calls. Solid Green/Blue/White: Everything working normally Flashing Green/Blue: Every light on your Wi-Fi gateway has a purpose.

The lights on your ONT can indicate a range of things, including whether the device is powered on, whether it's connected to the fiber-optic network, and whether there are any errors or ...



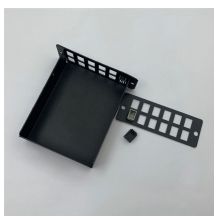

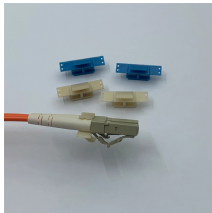
