

Senegal Trapezoidal Bridge



Overview

The majestic Faidherbe Bridge (1865), commissioned by Louis Faidherbe, stands as a true artistic masterpiece, extending 500 meters above the Senegal River, connecting the island - listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site - to the Sor district. 5 m (34 ft) wide, weighing 1,500 t (1,500 long tons; 1,700 short tons). The bridge was named Faidherbe Bridge by a decree of Napoleon III of France. The opening in 1885 of the Saint-Louis - Dakar railway increased the traffic over the bridge.



Faidherbe Bridge is a road bridge over the Senegal River which links the island of the city of Saint-Louis in Senegal to the African mainland. The metal bridge is 507.35 m long and 10.5 m wide, weighing ...



Composed of several iron arches, the bridge has a central mechanism that turns on a pillar to allow boat passage. The entire structure spans more than 1,000 feet (500 meters) and is ...
