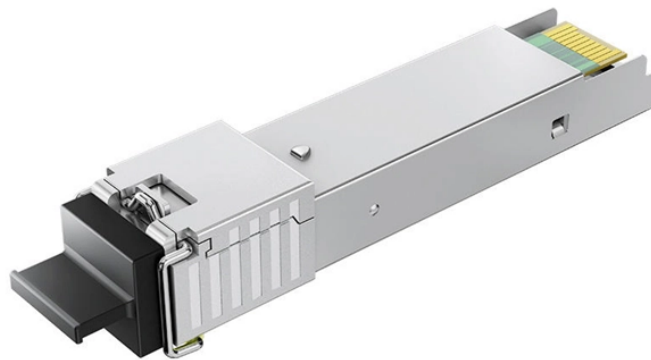


## The distribution box is not responding



### Overview

The five causes are: a settled or tilted box, outlet clogs from solids carryover, root intrusion or crushed laterals, cracked or deteriorated box structure, and a saturated drainfield that mimics D-box symptoms. A septic distribution box (D-box) is a concrete or plastic junction that evenly distributes wastewater from your septic tank to all drainfield lateral lines. When it fails, symptoms include uneven wet spots in the yard, slow indoor drains, and sewage odors. When it fails — and it will eventually — the consequences can reach \$30,000. Here's what every septic owner needs to know. At its core is the distribution box, or D-box.

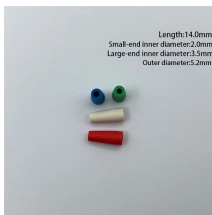
