Many fiber internet problems come from dirty connectors or loose plugs, not major faults. Power cycling or restarting your ONT (Optical Network Terminal) often resolves simple troubleshooting internet issues. Use the table below to see expert-recommended first steps for fiber. The first step in solving any problem is recognizing that there is one. Common signs that your optical cable may not be working include: X5 Fiber cleaver □ Fiber Fixture is suitable for bare fiber, pigtail and leather cable. 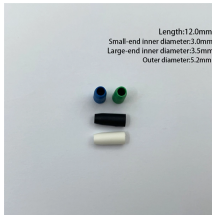

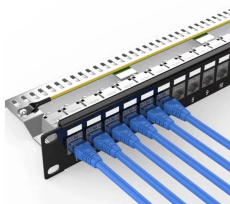
