Interquartile Range (IQR): The box plot shows the middle 50% of scores (i., the range between the 25th and 75th percentile). 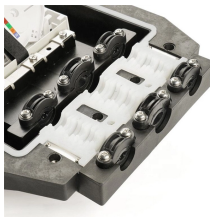
